The Louis Stokes Alliance for Minority Participation (LSAMP) is a program supported by the National Science Foundation and the California State University to:

- Increase the number of underrepresented minority students (African-American, Hispanic or Latino-American, Native Americans and Pacific Islander) who graduate from the CSU with baccalaureate degrees in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM).
- Increase the number of underrepresented minority students who seek graduate degrees (Master's degree, PhD) in STEM disciplines.

If you are (1) a junior or senior and (2) a member of one or more of the above described groups and (3) you are enrolled in upper division STEM courses and (4) you plan to attend graduate school upon graduation, then you are eligible to participate in LSAMP. By participating in the LSAMP program you agree to have your name and address listed in a national directory of minority graduates in the STEM fields during the year in which you expect to apply to graduate.
